



YARN GUIDE

Here is a list of supplies that you will need to make any Daniel Bingham knitting pattern, including the patterns in the Daniel Bingham online store.

KNITTING GAUGE

We generally use either fingering or lace weight yarn using the needle sizes shown on the chart below for the main areas of knitting in stockinette stitch. The exact knitting gauge may vary by a stitch or row, depending on the yarn we are using (cotton, wool, textured or smooth). See our yarn selection guide below.

US	Metric	UK/Cdn	Yarn	Sts/inch	Rows/inch
1	2.25 mm	13	Fingering weight	9 - 9 1/2	12 - 13
0	2.00mm	14	Lace weight	10 - 11	13 - 14
00	1.75mm	15	Lace weight	12	16

FINGERING WEIGHT SELECTION GUIDE

Winter Wools

Yardage: approx 210 - 250 m per 50 grams
Wraps: approx 23 wraps per inch
Gauge: 9 sts and 13 rows with 1" using 2.25mm needles in stockinette stitch
Yarn no: 2/12 or 2/8
Examples: KnitPicks Palette, KnitPicks Essentials, JaggerSpun Mainline 2/8, JaggerSpun Heather Yarn 2/8

Summer Cottons

Yardage: approx 210 - 250 yd per 50 grams
Wraps: approx 25 wraps per inch
Gauge: 9 1/2 sts and 12 rows with 1" using 2.25mm needles in stockinette stitch
Yarn no: 5/2, #5
Examples: Anchor or DMC Cotton Pearl #5, Halcyon Pearl Cotton 2/5

LACE WEIGHT SELECTION GUIDE

Winter Wools

Yardage: 420 - 500 m per 50 grams
Wraps: approx 33 wraps per inch
Gauge: 12 sts and 16 rows with 1" using 1.75mm needles in stockinette stitch
Yarn no: 2/16, 2/18 or 2/8
Examples: KnitPicks Shadow, Shimmer, JaggerSpun Superfine Merino 2/18

Summer Cottons

Yardage: approx 420 - 500 m per 50 grams
Wraps: approx 33 wraps per inch
Gauge: 12 sts and 16 rows with 1" using 1.75mm needles in stockinette stitch
Yarn no: 10/2, #8
Examples: Anchor or DMC Cotton Pearl #8, Halcyon Pearl Cotton 2/10
